Right now you are wondering "Is Ironwood as accessible as they claim to be"? The answer is ABSOLUTELY! Ironwood Springs is truly accessible. Home of the National Wheelchair Sports Camp, Miracle Lodge and Conference Center was specifically designed with those with physical challenges in mind.

All buildings are equipped with wide doorways, ramps and/or elevators. Trails extending throughout Ironwood are paved. Activities at Ironwood are adaptive and accessible, regardless of one's ability. Miracle Lodge rooms are larger than traditional hotel rooms with extra space between beds allowing for wheelchair function. Bathrooms in each room have roll-under sinks and grab bars. Showers are either a roll-in, or are a tub/shower combination, each having handicap fold down seats and hand-held shower heads.



Ironwood Springs is designed to take away the worry. Come on out to Ironwood and relax, refresh and enjoy time with others!

Wheelchair Sports Camp Rates
